Sir,

Please, refer to your letter no. 597 Spl./EII/VII.B.4(1-E), dated 28.05.2021 on the above noted subject.

In this connection, it is submitted that no exclusive commercial court has been created/established in Chandigarh Sessions Division, however, the Hon'ble High Court, vide its letter no. 2117 Spl. Gazette-II(7-G), dated 26.11.2019 (**copy enclosed**) has forwarded the copies of Notification No. 10732-IH (8)-2019/16513 dated 01.11.2019 and NO. 10732-IH(8)-2019/16516 dated 01.11.2019 issued by the Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh.

It is further submitted that the Hon'ble High Court vide its aforesaid letter dated 26.11.2019 has directed this office to assign the cases of Commercial Disputes as per notification No. 10732-IH(8) 2019/16513 dated 01.11.2019 to Additional District Judge-II/Additional District Judge-III, apart from Additional District Judge-I. This office has also been directed to assign the cases of Commercial disputes as per notification no. 10732 IH(8) 2019/16516 dated 01.11.2019 to the Civil Judge (Sr.Divn.) or Additional Civil Judge (Sr.Divn.) or Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.) having more than 5 years service.

It is further submitted that as per the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble High Court, the cases of Commercial



No.21/27/2003-3FP2/122 In exercise of the powers conferred by the provisions to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Civil Services Rules, Volume-I, Part-I, namely:-

RULES

1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Civil Services (Amendment) Rules, Volume-I, Part-I, 2013
- (2) They shall come into force on and with effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Punjab Civil Services Rules, Volume-I, Part-I, in rule 15.1, in the table, in Serial No.67,-

(a) for clauses (g) and (h), and the entries relating thereto, the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:


